TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

BALI

- ◆ **Uluwatu Temple** - built in 11th century and it is one of the oldest and most important temples in Bali. Uluwatu Temple is a Hindu temple located on the cliff bank in south part of Bali peninsula. It is situated on the coral reef sordid to sea about 80 meters above the sea level. It is featured by a small dry forest which is mostly called by Alas Kekeran (interdict forest) which is belong to the temple and dwelt by a lot of monkeys and other animals. (Note: Do not bring along any food as the monkeys might "ROB" you).
- ◆ **Dreamland Beach** - as the name, this is the perfect beach that everyone has dreamed of. A soft beach, clear blue skies over stunning blue waters, just the mesmerizing sound of crashing waves, this is the land of dreams. On the shore, also adorned with beautiful rocky cliffs, exudes a charming atmosphere.
- ◆ **My Swing Bali** - enjoy a unique and unforgettable swing experience with breath taking views soaring into the sky. In addition, there are unique birdcages/nests for everyone to take pictures and check in.
- ◆ **Ubud Art Market** - is famous with sells a wide range of clothing, fabrics, masks and souvenirs. You can also find silver, batiks and paintings in various styles.
- ◆ **Ubud Palace** - an ancient complex in Bali with some fine carvings and courtyards. Also known as Puri Saren Agung, this is an important historical landmark for the Balinese and is easily accessible, with some great places to take "Bali-style" cultural photos.
- ◆ **Tanah Lot Temple** - built by one of the last priests to come to Bali from Java in the 16th century, its rituals include the paying of homage to the guardian spirits of the sea.
- ◆ **Kintamani Volcano** - is the most favorite tourist destinations in Bali with the active volcano of mount Batur and beautiful lake.
- ◆ **Tampak Siring Temple** - Pura Tirta Empul" is the temple of Tampak Siring, built around a sacred spring. The temple and its two bathing places have been used by the Balinese for over 1000 years for good health and prosperity.
- ◆ **Penglipuran Village** - The environment is pleasant and the traditional structures of the village are mostly well-preserved, faithful to the traditional methods of bamboo construction. Stone brick roads are distributed in an orderly manner, and quaint traditional buildings are interspersed with neatly constructed gardens. It has also been voted the cleanest village in the world. The reason is that the village is far from pollution and has no garbage. Residents impose littering ban on residents and tourists.

NUSA PENIDA

- ◆ **Kelingking Beach** - An incredible hidden beach framed by towering, steep cliffs, and deep turquoise blue waters further embraced by powdery white sand with the most amazing view like heaven on earth. The secluded beach itself is down a rugged 400m cliffside hike. From this viewpoint, visitors look down onto the white sand enveloped by the famous limestone headland that reaches out into the Indian Ocean.
- ◆ **Broken Beach** - is the archway that wraps around the bay allowing water to flow in and out from the ocean. Where there is reach of cliffs 50-200 meters high. Cliff is a circular shape and the middle forms holes like caves or tunnels sea. The seawater as if caught in the middle of the cliff which makes it seem like a big pond.
- ◆ **Angel Billabong** - the natural infinity pool is framed by rock cliffs. The name comes from a mythic story of this place is the place for Angel baths.

观光景点:

巴厘岛

- ◆ **乌鲁瓦图断崖庙** - 建于十一世纪,是巴厘岛上最悠久又具代表性的庙宇。从这里可以观看巴厘岛最南端,拥有壮丽海洋景观的断崖(情人崖)。
- ◆ **梦幻海滩** - 顾名思义,这就是大自然给予你梦寐以求的完美海滩。一滩柔软白珍珠的沙滩,清澈的蓝色天空盖过迷人的蓝色水域,只有令人着迷的海浪冲击声,这就是梦想之地。在梦幻岛岸上,也装饰着美丽的岩石悬崖,散发出迷人的气氛。
- ◆ **乌布秋千/鸟巢** - 最热门最火的网红活动-荡秋千!在高耸入云的壮丽美景,享受与众不同及令人难忘的荡秋千体验。除此之外,还有造型独特的鸟笼/鸟巢让大家拍照打卡。
- ◆ **乌布艺术市场** - 在这边能看到贩卖着各式巴厘岛传统艺品的摊贩如木头猫、染布沙龙、竹编包等等,物美廉价,您可以在这边选购带回家送亲友的礼物,提醒您,在乌布传统市场购物别忘了杀价哦!
- ◆ **乌布皇宫** - 是巴厘岛一座古老的建筑群,拥有一些精美的雕刻和庭院。也被称为PURI SAREN AGUNG,这是巴厘岛人的重要历史地标,而且交通便利,有一些拍摄“巴厘岛风格”文化照片的好地方。
- ◆ **海神庙** - 这庙是巴厘岛最重要的印度教庙宇代表,始建于16世纪。该庙坐落在海边一块巨大的岩石上,每逢涨潮之时,岩石被海水包围,整座寺庙与陆地隔绝,孤绝地立在海水中,只在落潮时才与陆地相连。
- ◆ **金塔马尼火山** - 欣赏巴杜尼山美丽的巴杜尼湖还可以看到全景半活跃的火山,高度约海拔1400米。
- ◆ **圣泉庙** - 这座庙约有1000年历史,庙里终年畅通清澈泉水,让当地信徒们饮用、淋浴甚至治病驱魔。
- ◆ **彭里普兰村** - 环境宜人,村里的传统建筑大多保存完好,忠实于竹子建造的传统方法。石砖路错落有致,古色古香的传统建筑与错落有致的园林交相辉映。几乎周围的一切都是由丰富的植物构成的。它也被评为世界上最干净的村庄。原因是村里远离污染,没有垃圾。居民对居民和游客禁止乱扔垃圾。

努沙珀尼达岛

- ◆ **精灵沙滩** - 一个令人难以置信的隐蔽海滩,周围环绕着高耸陡峭的悬崖和深蓝绿色的海水,进一步被粉状的白色沙滩所包围,拥有最令人惊叹的景色,如人间天堂。僻静的海滩本身就在崎岖不平的400米悬崖边徒步旅行中。从这个角度,游客可以俯视被延伸到印度洋的著名石灰岩岬角所包围的白色沙滩。
- ◆ **破碎沙滩** - 岛上令人难以置信的小海湾,海湾的亮点和被称为破碎海滩的原因是环绕海湾的拱门,允许海水流入和流出海洋。那里有50-200米高的悬崖峭壁,悬崖呈圆形,中间形成洞穴或被誉为海的隧道。海水仿佛被困在悬崖中间,使它看起来像一个大池塘。
- ◆ **天使浴池** - 天然无边泳池,四周环绕着悬崖峭壁。这个名字来源于一个神话故事,据说是天使沐浴的地方。
