TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

KYOTO

- ◆ **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. - Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) - Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.
- ◆ **Ninenzaka & Sannenzaka** - This is a stone road on a hillside, the Shinto of Kiyomizu Temple. Souvenir shops, pottery shops and restaurants line the roadside. Nearby are Yasaka Shrine, Maruyama Park, Kodaiji Temple, and Hokanji Temple. According to the Cultural Properties Protection Act, it is listed as an important traditional building preservation area.

KOBE

- ◆ **Kobe Suma Seaworld** - Situated along the scenic southwestern coast of Kobe City, Suma Seaworld Park is one of the Kansai region's most popular aquariums. Step into a vibrant underwater world featuring marine life from Japan's coastal seas to the far corners of the globe — from sharks and penguins to sea turtles and dazzling tropical fish. Don't miss the spectacular dolphin and sea lion shows, a delightful highlight filled with fun and laughter. Visitors can also get up close to sea creatures at the touch pool, or stroll through the giant underwater tunnel surrounded by shimmering schools of fish — a truly immersive ocean experience.
- ◆ **Kobe Sake Brewery** - Experience the rich heritage of Japanese sake, a traditional rice wine that can be enjoyed either warm or chilled. With an ever-expanding range of flavors and aromas, sake has captivated drinkers around the world. Among Japan's many brewing regions, the Nada-Gogō area (Nada Five Districts) — stretching across western Kobe and Nishinomiya — stands out as the most renowned sake-producing region in the country. Here, visitors can explore historic breweries, learn about the art of sake-making, and savor the delicate taste of freshly brewed sake.

HYOGO

- ◆ **Hyogo** is western Japan's premier ski destination, home to a variety of ski resorts that cater to everyone — from energetic snowboarders to families seeking gentle slopes. The region offers everything from lively, full-facility resorts to cozy, family-friendly ski areas that feel just like your own backyard. Whether you're a beginner or an expert, Hyogo's slopes promise fun and excitement for all.

OSAKA

- ◆ **Osaka Castle (photo shop)** - It is a symbol of Osaka, encompassing thirteen buildings that have been designated as Important Cultural Properties by the Japanese government.
- ◆ **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - A largest shopping area covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop. There are a lot of boutiques and specialty stores, including Japanese cuisine, and can enjoy the different flavors of various countries in the world.

观光景点:

京都

- ◆ **清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙, 整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各样的日本手工艺品, 陶瓷、日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。
- ◆ **二年坂, 三年坂** - 这是一条山坡上的石板路, 即清水寺的神道。纪念品店, 陶器店和餐厅林立路旁。附近有八坂神社、圆山公园、高台寺、法观寺。根据文化财保护法, 被列为重要传统的建造物群保存地区。

神户

- ◆ **神户须磨海洋世界** - 位于神户市西南部的海滨地带, 是关西地区著名的水族馆之一。馆内展示了从日本近海到世界各地的海洋生物, 包括鲨鱼、企鹅、海龟及五彩缤纷的热带鱼。最受欢迎的是精彩的海豚与海狮表演, 充满动感与笑声。除了欣赏表演, 游客还可以走进触摸池与海洋生物近距离接触, 或透过巨大的海底隧道观赏成群游动的鱼群, 仿佛置身海底世界。
- ◆ **神户清酒酿酒厂** - 日本清酒是一种由大米发酵而制成酒类饮品, 可以热饮或冷饮。目前为止清酒的种类和口味从未像现在这样的琳琅满目, 世界上越来越多的人喜欢并享受着这种独特的酒饮品。虽然日本全国各地都有生产, 但Nada-Gogō (灘五郷)地区, 西神户和西宫, 却是全日本国内最著名的生产基地。

兵库县

- ◆ **兵库**是西日本地区滑雪场最集中的区域, 是关西各地双/单板滑雪爱好者的经常光顾的地方。有项目齐全充满活力的滑雪场, 有面向家庭游客的像自家门前的滑雪场。每个人都能按照自己的水平找到适合自己的滑雪场。

大阪

- ◆ **大阪城堡(外观)** - 是大阪的象征, 包含了十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- ◆ **心斋桥** - 大阪最大的购物区, 也是日本最长的天缝式购物街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店。
